SUPERVISION OF USE OF FACILITIES

The Board of Trustees, upon the recommendation of the District Superintendent, may appoint a person who shall have charge of the grounds, preserve order, protect the school property, plan, promote, and supervise recreational activities, and do all things necessary in the capacity of a representative of the Board of Trustees. He shall have the power of a peace officer to carry out the provisions and the intents and purposes of this article.
(EC 16560)

The use of school district facilities shall be contingent upon the presence of a duly authorized custodian. It shall be the duty of said custodian to open and close said facilities, to see that all rules and regulations pertaining to such facilities are enforced, and to report any violations or attempted violations to the District Superintendent. Whenever the District Superintendent shall ascertain that any of the rules or regulations have been violated, he shall revoke such permit as have been given to the individual, society, group, or organization in question, and may recommend to the Board of Trustees that no further permits be issued to said individual, society, group or organization.

In the case of an athletic program or activity, a certificated employee shall open, supervise, and close the facilities used.
